Many of his punting pictures have appeared in the British press, including The Daily Telegraph, The Times and the Guardian.

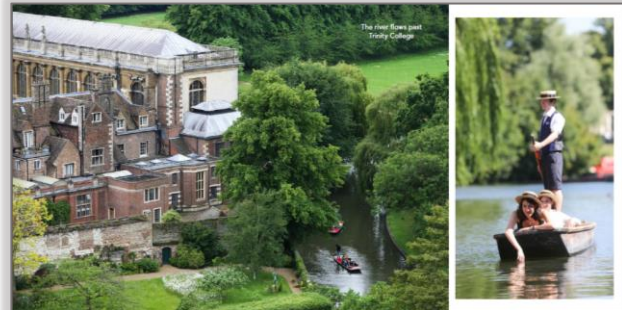
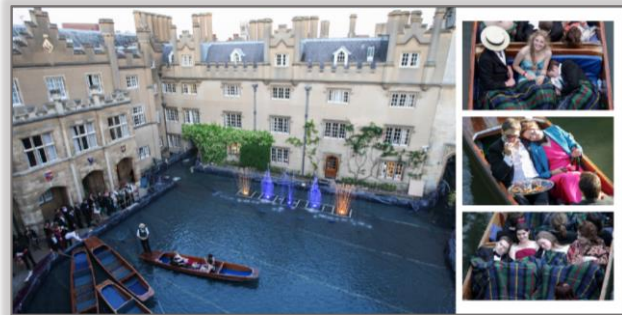
Now his unique portfolio has been compiled into a stunning new 100-page book, which epitomizes the changing face of the river throughout the year.
